ELECTORAL ROLL

In October 2017 legislation was passed to redefine the definition of a parishioner and included requirements for Voting Parishioners to 'elect' or choose to be added to the Parish Electoral Roll. Each Parish's Electoral Rolls will be revised every three years and the current one will be enacted in preparation for the 2018 Annual Meeting of Parishioners (AMP), and therefore, will run from 2018-2020. If you are eligible to be entered on the Electoral Roll and have not yet signed up, please complete and return this form to the Church Office as advised so you may be eligible to vote at our next AMP.

Electoral rolls will enable us to provide a true indication of the membership and strength of the Church, both locally and within the Diocese. Putting your name on the roll is a way of saying "I belong"; it is an act of commitment to your local Church and to the Church as a whole. Joining the electoral roll opens up the way for greater involvement in the life of the Church, at deanery, diocesan and national levels. You become entitled to vote at the AMP. With your name on the electoral roll the strength of the Church can be seen in our area, and across the diocese.

Notes

1. To be eligible to be entered on the electoral roll you must have been baptised or christened, and be a communicant member of the Church.
2. If your 18th Birthday falls in the next 12 months you may complete the form and become eligible to be entered on the Roll on your birthday.

*(ref 4B) If you are **not** a resident inyou can elect to be on the roll if you are an habitual worshipper of Church and live in another area but are not enrolled to vote with any other Christian Church.

The information on this form will be used only to assist and help our communications with you in the Church, for example by your parish priest or bishop and will not otherwise be shared with third parties.
